

SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY NOTICE TO FAMILIES

PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY WITH YOUR CHILD

The school uniform is a visible symbol of our faith-centered community, reflecting our shared identity within a Catholic education. By wearing the uniform, students shine through their character, actions, and achievements. Adherence to the Uniform Code shows respect for oneself, others, our school, and the learning environment.

General Uniform Expectations

- Uniforms must be clean, complete, properly fitted, and in good condition.
- Clothing may not be oversized, undersized, or worn out.
- No substitutions are permitted for any part of the uniform without prior permission.
- Students must be in full uniform everyday of school .

Exceptions (Jeans for Jesus, Spirit Days, Free Dress Days) will be communicated in advance.

Violation of the uniform policy may result in the student being sent home.

Standard Uniform Code (Boys & Girls)

All uniform items must be purchased through Tommy Hilfiger or the school office/website.

Pants:

- Gray cotton twill slacks

Shorts:

- Gray shorts (Not permitted on Mass days)
- Girls in grades 4–8 may NOT wear shorts (skort or pants only)

Shirts:

- White or navy polo (short or long sleeve) with school logo
- Must be tucked in at all times

Girls' Skort or Jumper:

- Jumpers: K–3 only
- Skorts: Grades 4–8

Length must be NO SHORTER than three fingers above the knee
(this also applies to free dress)

Belts:

- Solid brown or black leather belt required with pants or shorts (boys and girls)

Shoes: See “School Shoes Made Easy” Page 4.

- Black or white Athletic, Oxford, or Mary Jane style (black only)
- No sandals, flip-flops, or boots
- No colored stripes, logos, or patterns
- Black or white shoelaces, tied at all times
- Refer to “School Shoes Made Easy” page

Socks:

- Solid black or white only

Sweatshirts / Outerwear:

- School-imprinted logo sweatshirt required (ordered via school website)
- Sweaters, vests, and lightweight jackets with logo available through Tommy Hilfiger

Please note: Some items may take several weeks to arrive; order early

Girls – Options & Guidelines

- Preschool–Grade 3:
 - School plaid jumper, pants, or shorts with school polo
 - Jumpers available only through Tommy Hilfiger
 - No Skorts
- Grades 4–8:
 - School plaid skort or gray side-pleat skort, or pants
 - No shorts
- Black leggings, black tights, or black bike shorts may be worn under skort or jumper only
- Shoes: Athletic, Oxford, or Mary Jane style (black only)
 - No sandals, flip-flops, boots or heels
- Hair accessories: White, navy, or uniform plaid only
- No makeup of any kind, No nail polish, and No artificial nails
- Hair must be traditional and natural in color
- Long-sleeve undershirts under polos must be black or white



Boys – Options & Guidelines

- Hair must be traditional, out of the face, above the collar (minimum 3”), natural color only
 - No shaved designs or distracting hairstyles
 - School reserves the right to require a haircut
- Shoes: Black athletic or Oxford style only
 - No sandals, flip-flops, or boots

P.E. Uniform (Grades 4–8 Only)

- School Logo P.E. T-shirt, shorts (Available in school office)
- Logo sweatshirt, and Logo sweatpants (Available via School website)
- P.E. uniforms may be worn to school on designated P.E. days ONLY



Jewelry, Watches & Accessories

- Jewelry must be simple and religious only (cross, crucifix, Mary, saints).
- No rings, bracelets, anklets, nose rings or gauges
- No hats, caps, beanies, headgear, or hoods.
- Simple, non-distracting watches only; no smart watches (calls, texting, Wi-Fi, games, data).

Outerwear & Footwear

- Overcoats/raincoats only with a school sweatshirt under.
- Boots/rain boots only when weather requires.

Thank you for your continued cooperation and support in upholding our school's uniform standards and fostering a respectful, faith-centered learning environment.

Free Dress Guidelines

Please review these guidelines with your child. Free dress is a privilege and must be neat, modest, and appropriate for a Catholic school environment. Parents are responsible for proper attire. The school reserves the right to enforce compliance, including sending students home if needed.

- Closed-toe athletic shoes are required.
- T-shirts with or without collars may be worn.
 - No inappropriate language, images, or advertising.
- Dresses and skirts length must be no shorter than three fingers above the knee
- Jeans may be worn if they are in good condition.
 - No shorts of any kind
 - Black or blue jeans only on Spirit Days and Jeans for Jesus days
 - No holes or rips
 - No oversized or baggy jeans, must not drag on ground
 - No form-fitting or tight jeans
- Not permitted: Sweats, shorts, yoga pants, leggings, jeggings or cut-offs.
- Not permitted: spaghetti straps, tank tops, crop tops, or short tops.
 - When arms are raised, the waist/midsection must remain covered.
 - Nothing form fitting or low cut . All clothing must be modest.
- Jackets and sweaters must be school-appropriate.
- No use of hood on hooded sweatshirts.

Consequences

Failure to follow dress code standards may result in loss of free dress privileges, being sent home to correct the violation, detention, or suspension for repeat offenses.
